



Conflict Minerals Compliance

JC Engineering is committed to ethical sourcing and supports global initiatives aimed at eliminating the use of conflict minerals. “Conflict Minerals” refers to Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, and Gold (3TG) mined in regions where their revenues might finance armed groups, notably in the eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries. Although JC Engineering is not subject to the Dodd-Frank Act, we adhere to its spirit by implementing rigorous supplier verification procedures.

We require all our suppliers to certify that their materials are sourced from regions free of conflict and maintain detailed documentation on the origin of their materials. Our due diligence program includes regular audits and reviews of our supply chain, ensuring that we have not knowingly purchased steel or materials from the DRC or neighbouring countries such as Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Congo Republic, Rwanda, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.

This proactive approach guarantees that our supply chain remains free from conflict minerals and supports broader social and environmental responsibility initiatives.
